



**NOTICE OF RACE (Revised 4/05)
APRIL 17&18, 2010**

Organizing Authority: Richmond Yacht Club, Point Richmond, California

RULES: The Regatta will be governed by the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing .

Eligibility: All center board boats and multihulls are invited to the challenging breezes and waves of San Francisco Bay. A fleet must have 5 eligible boats, otherwise they will sail in the Open Class with a Portsmouth handicap. *Intermediate and Advanced El Toro and Opti, are invited. No beginner, or Green Fleet, sailors please.*

Registration: ON-LINE ONLY at www.richmondyc.org.

Need to registration separately for **Saturday's Races** and **Sunday's Pursuit Race**. All fee must be paid in full before beginning official competition.

Cost: Saturday races will be \$25 US for single handed boats and \$35 for crewed boats.
Sunday's Pursuit Race, will be \$20. The entry fees will include all racing, and regatta awards.

COURSES:

April 17, Saturday: Mark racing on two different courses: Southampton, and Potrero Channel.

April 18, Sunday: Pursuit Racing – two different pursuit courses to be announced at the Skippers Meeting.

SCHEDULE:

Check in: 9AM (only necessary for sail # changes or payment)
Skippers Meeting: 10:30 AM----- Fleet assignment
1st Race Warning: 12 Noon ---- Races 2nd ,3rd ,etc immediately after finish of Race 1

Sunday April 18:

Skippers Meeting: 10:30 AM, Starts and times designated at meeting

SCORING: Saturday: 2 races will constitute a series and boat's series score will be the total of her races.
Sunday: A reverse handicap start.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Well be available at www.richmondyc.org before the regatta.

TROPHIES: First, Second and Third Place for fleets of 10 or more, First and Second for Fleets of 7, First for fleets of 5. First 5 places of Pursuit Race awarded on Sunday.

DINNER, AWARDS, ENTERTAINMENT AND MOVIE/RAFFLE SAT. NIGHT:

A great dinner by RYC's own talented Chef Mike, followed by awards for the days racing and an event – movie or raffle, depending on the mood of the moment.
